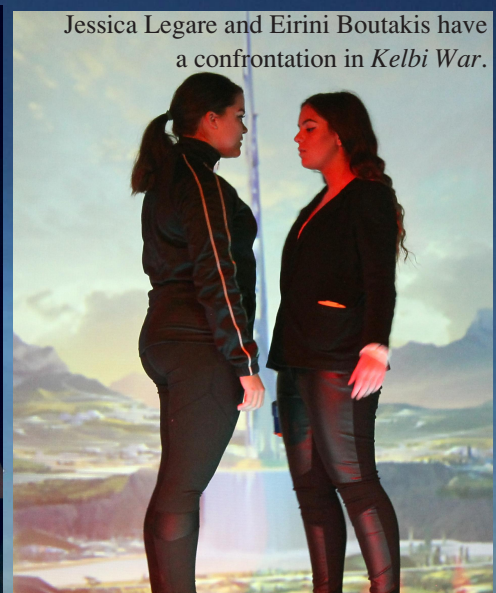

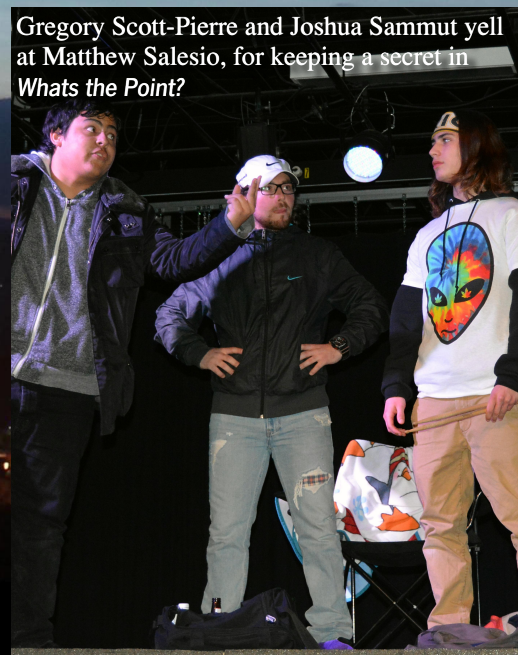

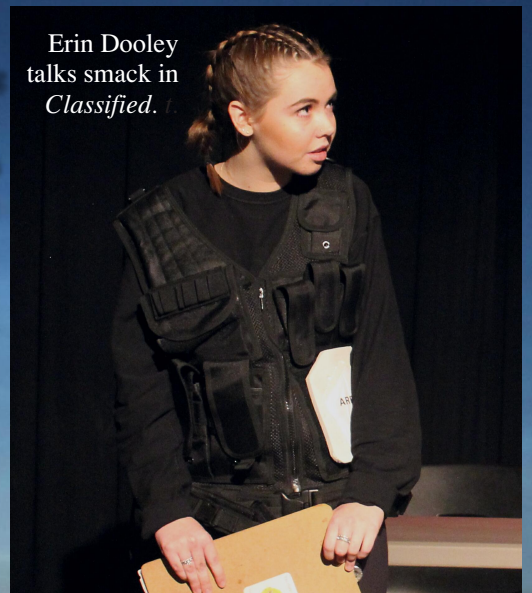

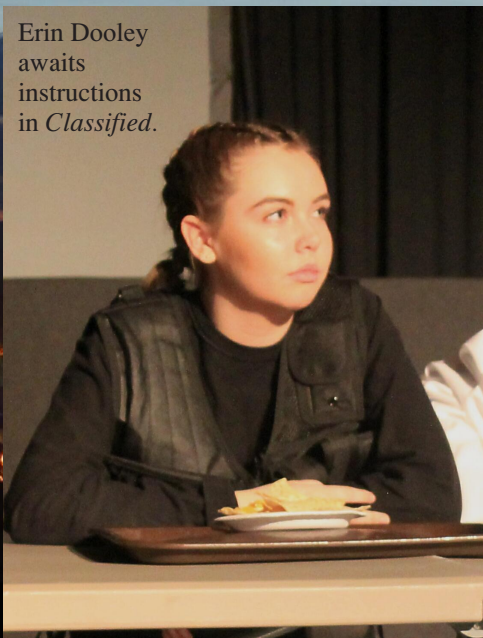
A Night to Remember
